Prayer Shawl Ministry Sunday Nov 14 10:00 A.M.

We have a wonderful Prayer Shawl Ministry at ORUMC. Over the last decades hundreds of prayer shawls have been distributed in our community and around the country, (some even traveled abroad!).

Every second Thursday of the month, loving hands at ORUMC gather to knit and crochet beautiful prayer shawls and blankets for those who are experiencing illness or other difficulty. Each shawl begins with prayers for the recipient, and petitions are continued throughout the creation of the shawl. When the shawl is completed, it receives a final consecration from our pastor and knitters. The shawl then receives a label and special prayer message for the recipient before being sent on its way.

Prayer shawls are a tangible way to comfort those facing difficulties and a loving reminder of God's love and presence. There are no specific guidelines for receiving a prayer shawl. Anyone who is in need of prayer, hope, comfort, and love may have a shawl. Prayer shawls are usually knitted or crocheted, but they can also be woven, sewn, quilted, machine knitted, etc. Patterns and yarn are available at the church. Prayer shawls are available by request for family members or friends.

If you would like to knit or crochet shawls to contribute to this ministry of prayer and comfort, please join us on the second Thursday of the month at church 10:00am – 11:00 a.m. If you have any questions, please

contact Mary Knoppel, Robyn Gatti or call the church office.

Baptismal shawls are also made by this group. They are given as a baptismal gift from the church for each baby or child that is baptized.

Patterns and yarn are available. One does not need to attend meetings to contribute a shawl.


